RULES OF THE ROAD, PLEASE READ AND HEED.

The bicycle is legally defined as a vehicle in Kentucky; therefore, bicyclists have rights and duties like those of motor vehicle drivers. On all public roads where cycling is allowed, the bicyclist must: Obey ALL traffic signs, signals and other control devices. Ride with vehicular traffic as near to the right of the road as practical. Use standard arm signals to alert other bicyclists and motorists of your intentions. Ride in a consistent, predictable manner. By the law you are not allowed to ride any more than two abreast at any time. All riders should use verbal signals to advise riders behind them of their actions (i.e., stopping, right, left, hole, dog, car-back, car-up, etc.).

RIDER SAFETY!!!

Safety is a major concern. We require all riders to wear an ANSI approved bicycling helmet (on their heads). Children under 18 are welcome, but must ride with a responsible adult rider at all times. We also deliberately limit the number of riders to keep road congestion to a minimum.

DIRECTIONS TO RIDE HEADQUARTERS AT THE LUDLOW, KY, K of C HALL:

Southbound I-71/I-75, take the first exit (Covington) after crossing the Ohio River and bear right. Turn left onto KY Rt. 8 and follow to Ludlow. The K of C hall is 2.6 miles from the bridge. Northbound I-71/I-75, take Fifth Street exit (Covington), turn left at the first traffic light past the Quality Inn (Philadelphia Street). Go two blocks to the stop sign at W. Third Street. Turn left (in front of the Holiday Inn) onto Third Street. Go one block on Third Street. Turn right onto KY Route 8 and follow Route 8 West to the Ludlow K of C Hall. SAG vehicles looking for riders experiencing problems will patrol all Routes. All routes will have painted road markings and detailed maps will be provided. Nobody gets lost! Ride headquarters at the Ludlow K of C opens at 7:30 AM. Registered riders can arrive any time between 7:30 AM and NOON. There are no preset start times.
